CO₂ is a toxic gas and must be included as part of your COSHH assessment.

A confined space is a place which is substantially enclosed and where serious injury can occur from hazardous substances or such as lack of oxygen.

The Confined Space Regulations 1997 and Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999 require employers and self-employed people to carry out relevant risk assessments for all work activities.
